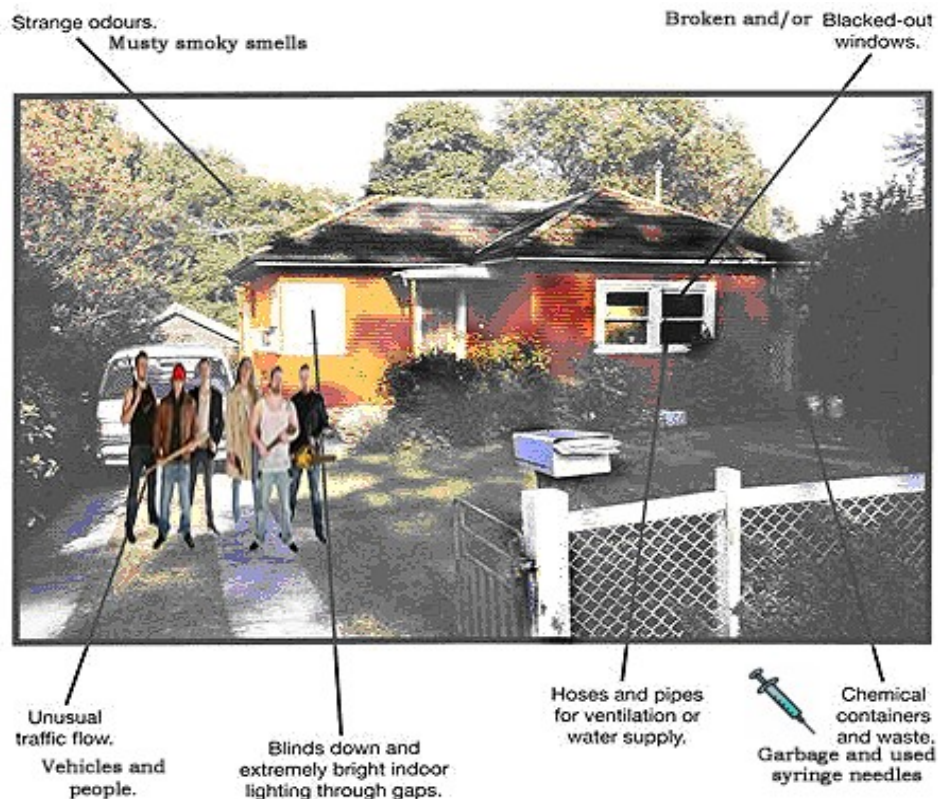


## HOW DO I KNOW IF A DRUG HOUSE IS ACTIVE IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD?

The business of a "Drug House" is more or less the same in any community. The danger signs of a "Drug House" are the public nuisance that it creates.

### DRUG HOUSE DANGER SIGNS

- 🚗 Increased short-term auto and pedestrian visits to a particular house or apartment. Loitering, trespassing.
- 🚗 Cars speeding up and down the street, honking or "burning rubber" as they speed away.
- 🗑️ Increase in litter such as used syringes, plastic bags, glass pipes, bottles, trash, stacks of used matches, and graffiti.
- 🚗 Increase in crimes like auto burglaries, home burglaries, robbery, vandalism, and assault.
- 🚗 Increase in noise such as loud voices, fights, gun fire, and loud radios especially at night. Increased animal security.
- 🚗 Active prostitution in or around the neighborhood. Increased panhandling for money.
- 🚗 Continuous "Repair" operations at a non-business location.
- 🚗 Open or broken windows at closed businesses or residences whose owners are temporarily absent.
- 🚗 Unusual noises such as gunshots, screaming, abnormally barking dogs, or any noise that is suggestive of foul play.
- 🚗 Unusual smells coming from location –musty, smoky.
- 🚗 Continuous traffic that comes and goes to the same location, usually staying for very short periods of time.
